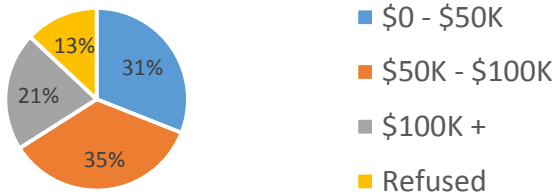

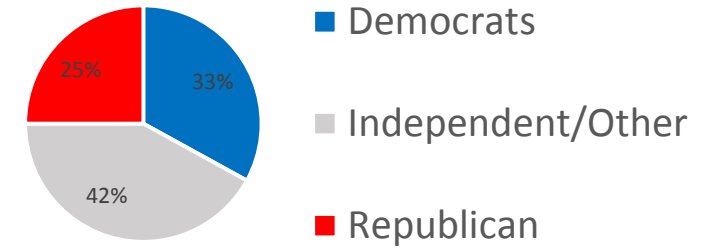

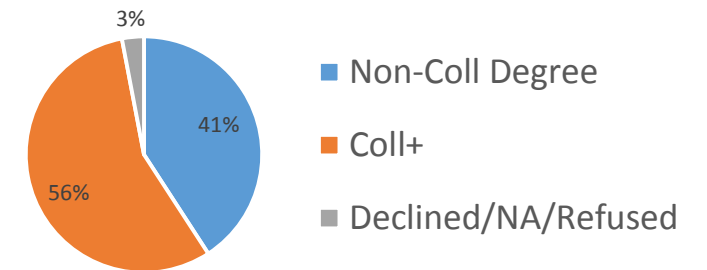

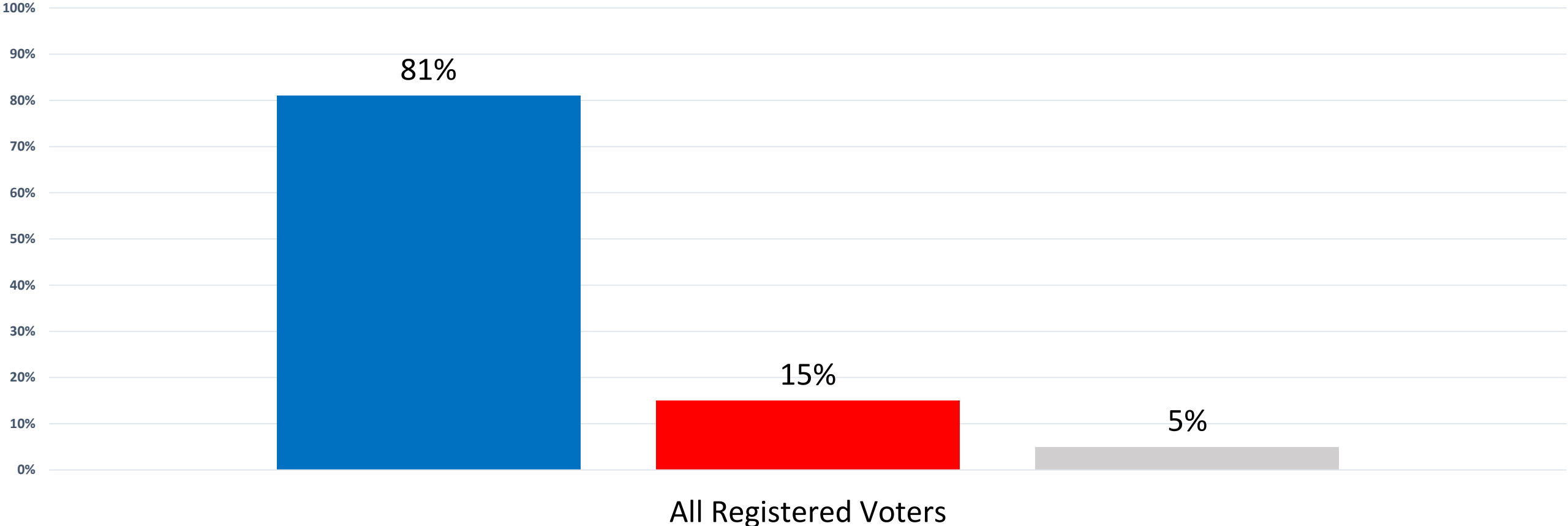

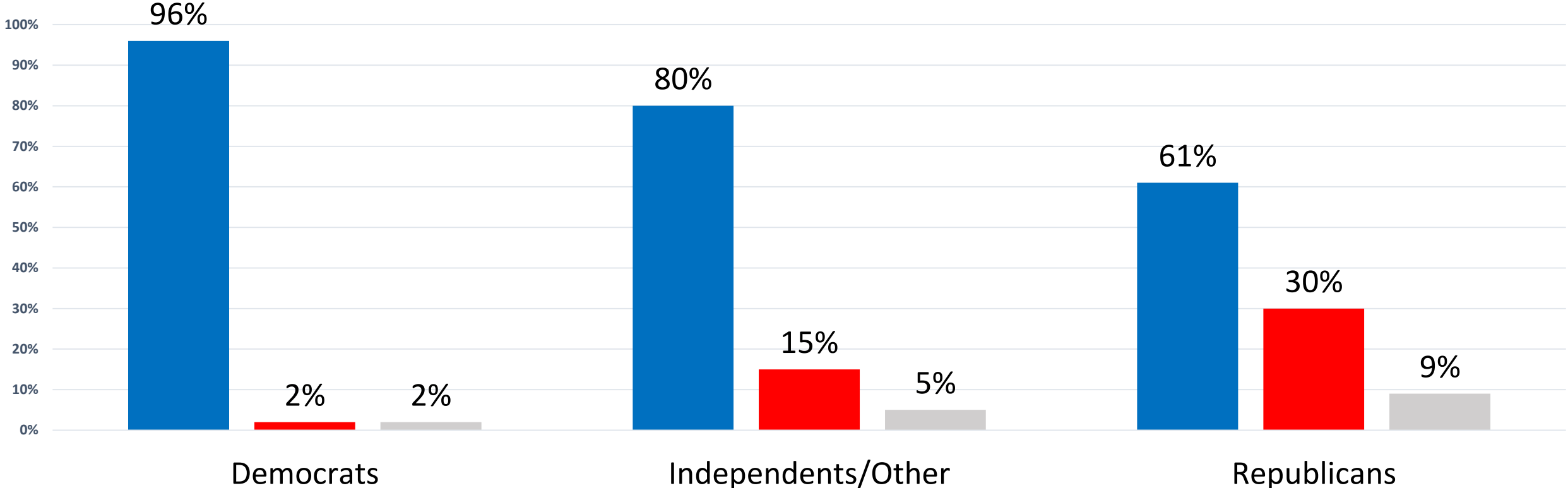
Do you think global warming is happening?

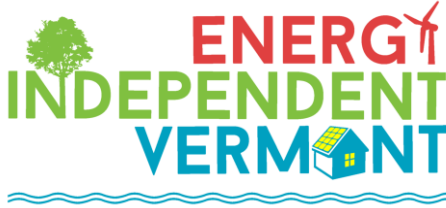
Across Political Parties, Majorities Think that Global Warming is Happening

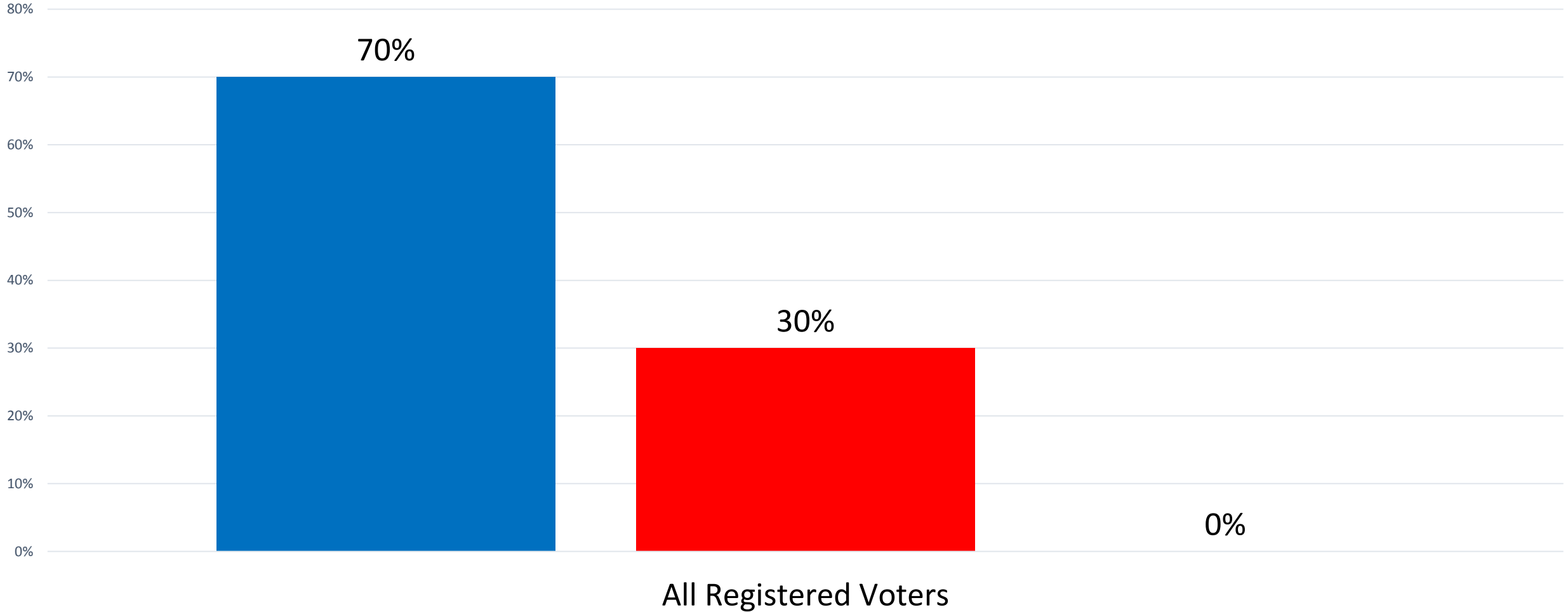

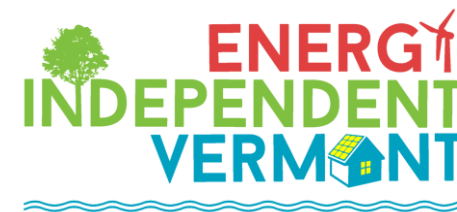
Seven in Ten Vermonters are Worried about Global Warming

■ Very & Somewhat Worried ■ Not Very & Not At All Worried ■ DK/NA



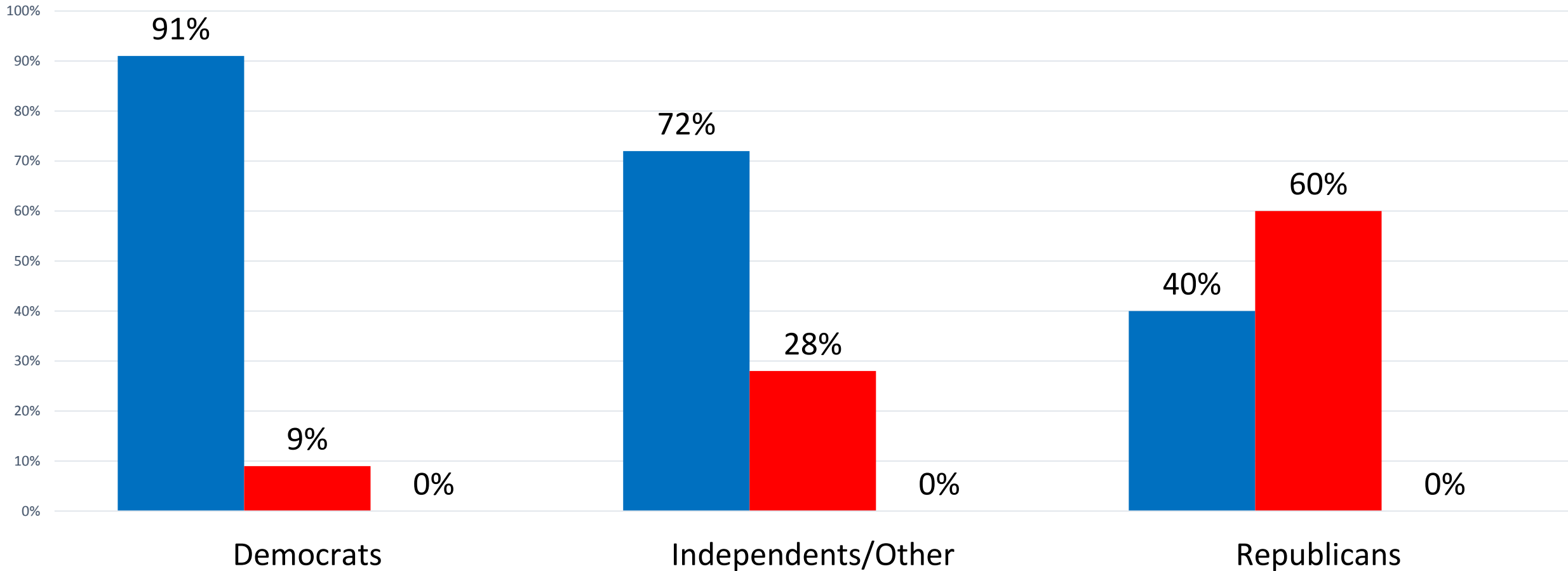
How worried are you about global warming?

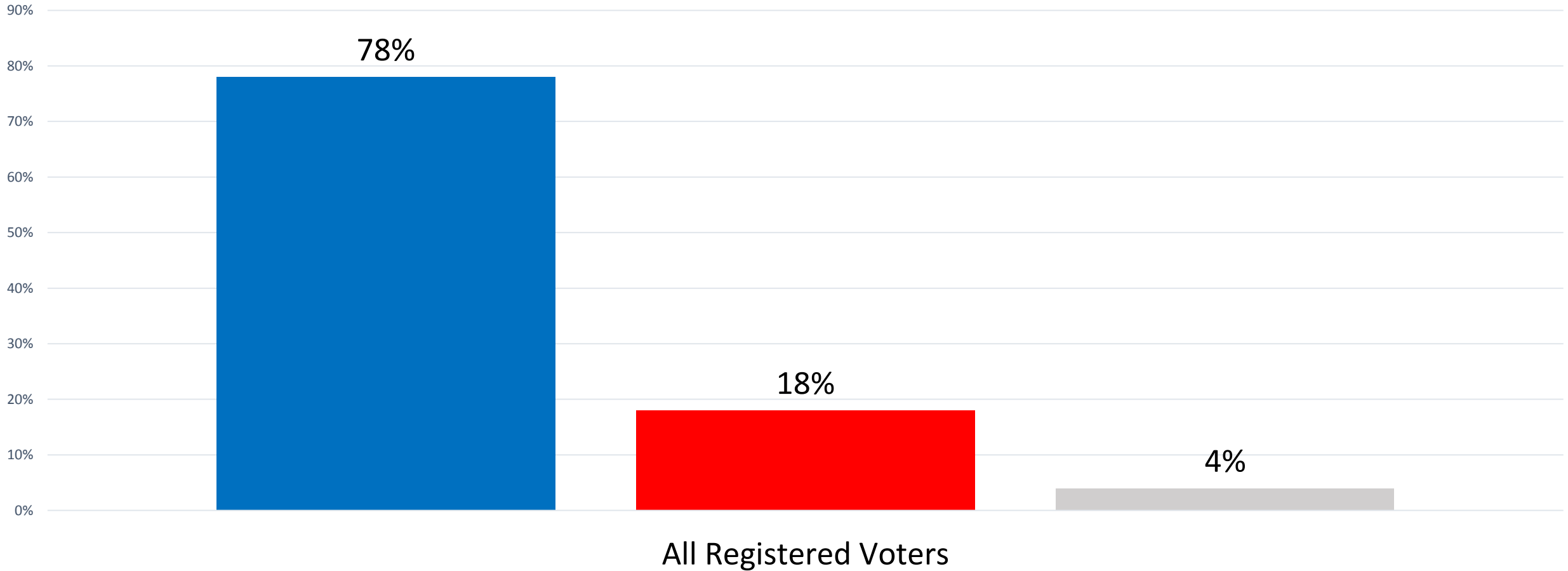

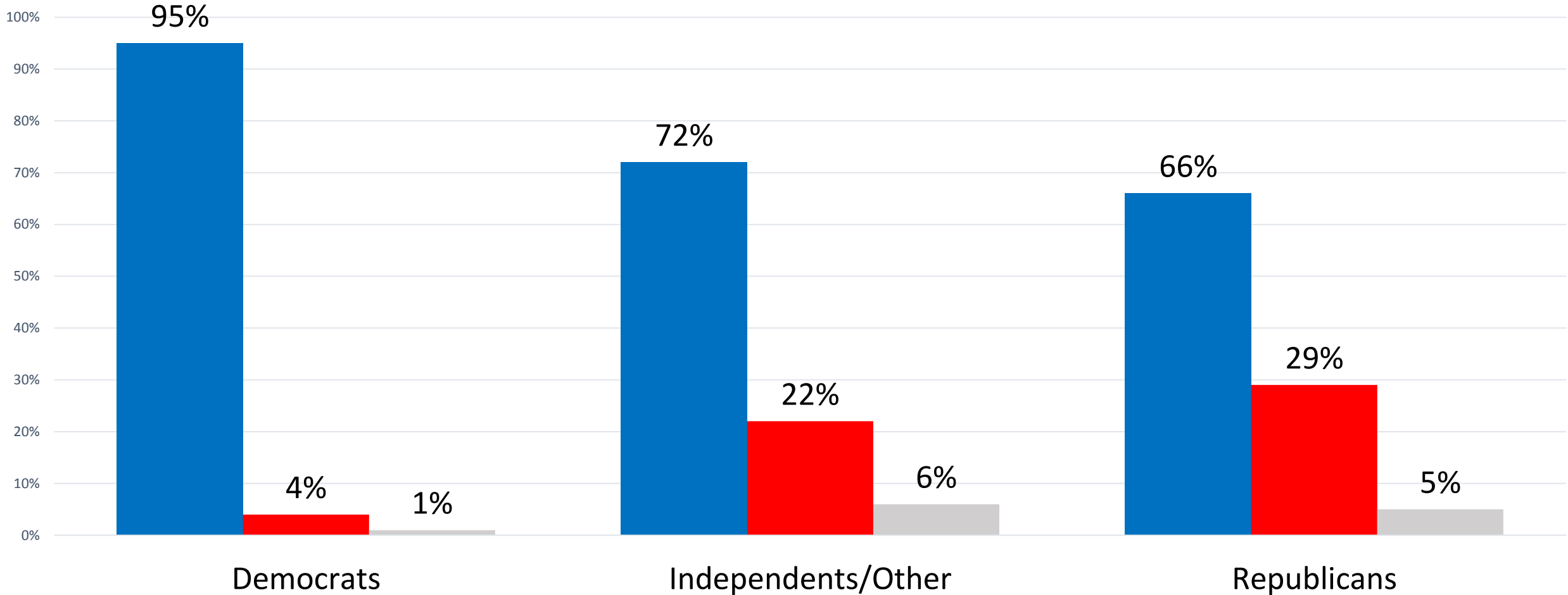


Majorities in All Parties Support Vermont's Renewable Energy Goal

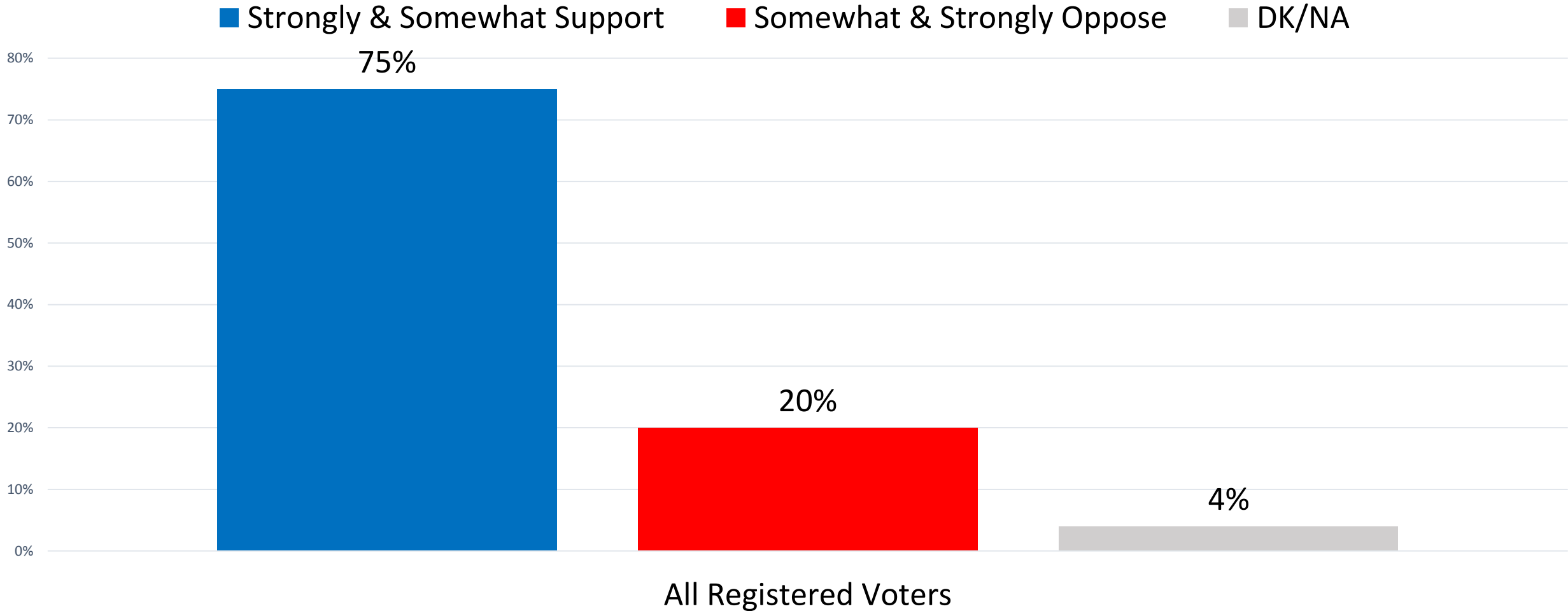


Vermont has a goal getting 90% of its energy from renewable sources by the year 2050. Do you support or oppose this goal for Vermont?

Three Quarters Support Vermont's Goal of Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions by at Least 80%



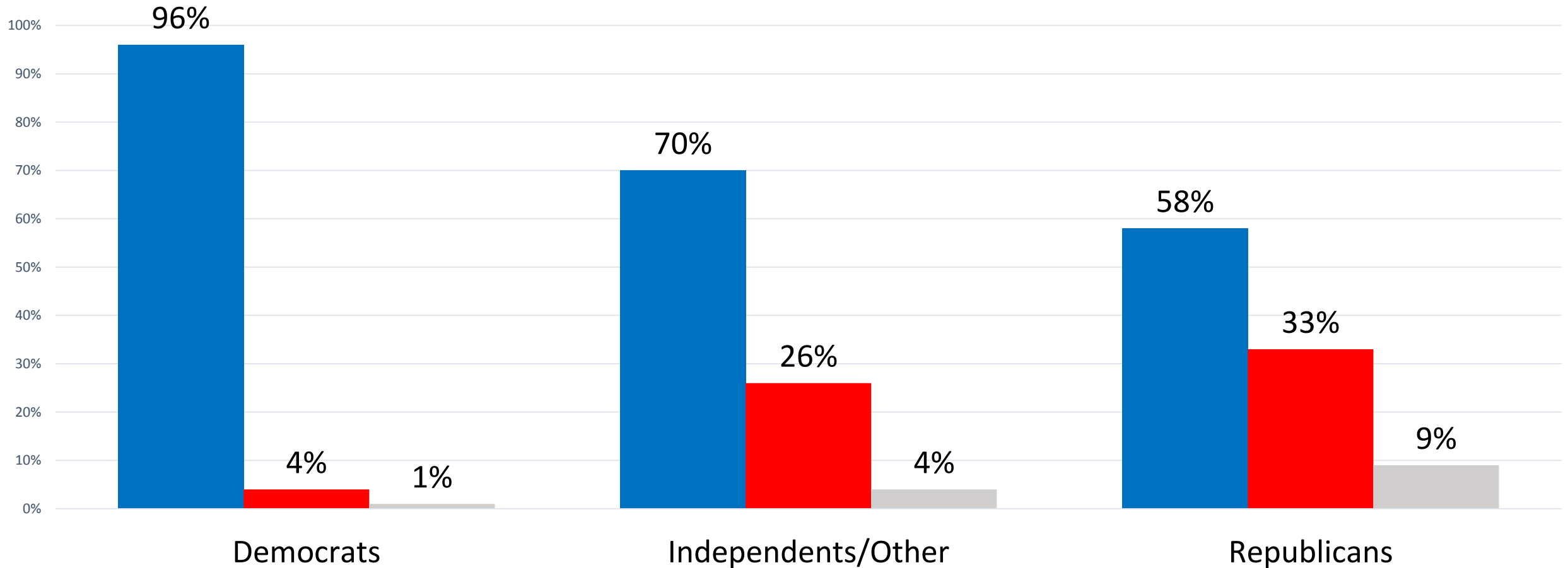

Majorities in All Parties Support the State's Greenhouse Gas Reduction Goal

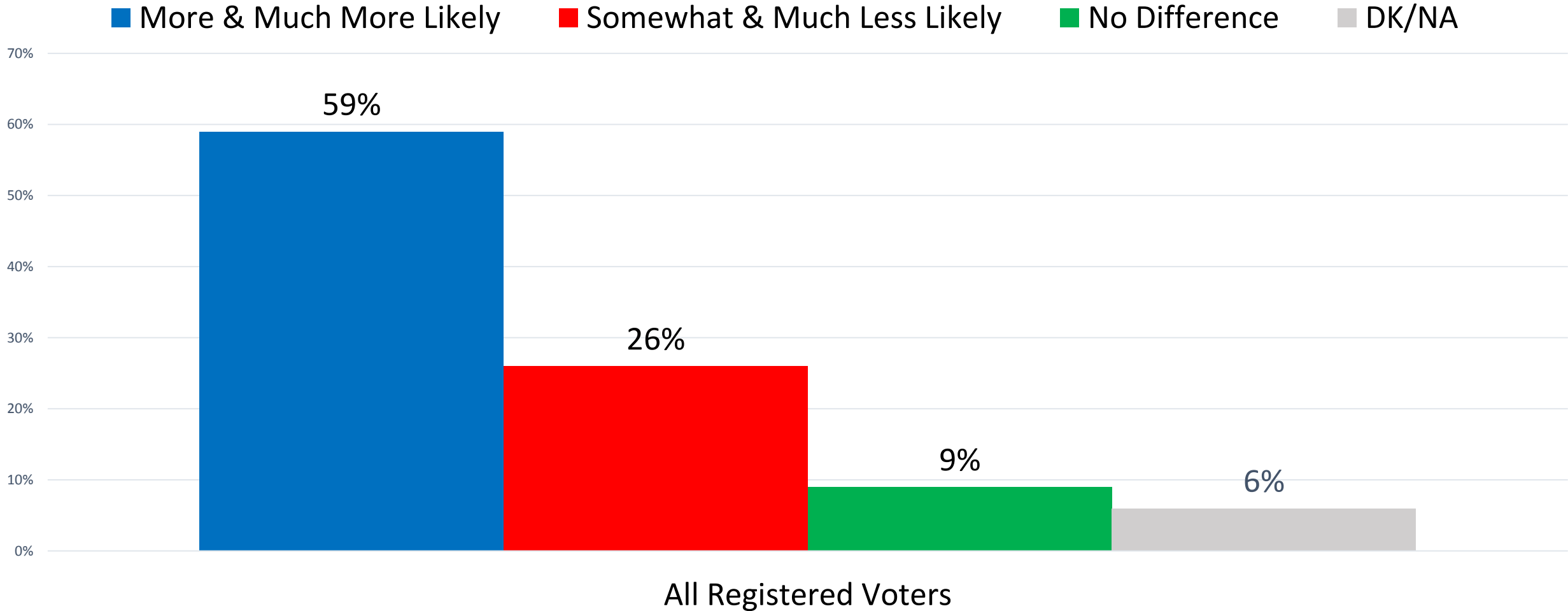
